Honor Club Score Sheet  
DUE: First Monday of October**

A 4-H Honor Club is one that incorporates the spirit of 4-H, as stated in the motto and pledge, in its meetings, project work, and club activities. Honor Club recognition is a challenge to all clubs to set goals and work together to achieve those goals. It is not intended as a contest between clubs.

It's easy to receive recognition as a 4-H Honor Club in Athens County! Simply complete the following checklist and return it to the Extension Office by the first Monday in October. Your form will be reviewed by the county 4-H Educator. All 4-H Clubs that meet the criteria will be recognized.

The Honor Club will be awarded in two size divisions (under 20 members and 20+ members) and two levels (gold and silver):

**4-H Clubs with Less Than 20 Members:**

GOLD HONOR CLUB = 300 POINTS  
SILVER HONOR CLUB = 200 POINTS

**4-H Clubs with 20 or More Members:**

GOLD HONOR CLUB = 400 POINTS  
SILVER HONOR CLUB = 300 POINTS

Honor Clubs will receive a banner from the 4-H Committee the first year they achieve Honor Club status, and a patch each subsequent year they do so.
