

Athens County 4-H Youth Development Program Horse Club Affiliate Membership Guidelines

Contract of Understanding

Must be submitted with Enrollment Form

It is important that proper care and training is supervised and handled by the 4-Her assigned to a horse project with the support of a knowledgeable advisor. Participants must also have an understanding of expectations when taking an equine project. Not only will he/she be expected to care for the horse during the fair, but during the entire lease and/or ownership process.

In an effort to provide support to riders who are members of non-horse clubs, Athens County 4-H expects riders to affiliate with a 4-H horse club. If you decide to take a horse project to the fair, you must meet with the advisor/mentor to work with the project horse and gain knowledge and skills that will benefit your involvement in the horse program. You will be assigned a stall near your affiliate club during the fair and will have support from the club if/when you need assistance while working with your horse project.
