Old Business:

Treasure's Report: Nan Needs -

- Current balance of \$5400.21

Committee Reports:

• **Children's Garden:** Michael and Debi – made new main gate to garden; gate swings all the way open and now has nice hinges, and a latch pin. This is for the gate that is facing the bike path; there are plans on working on the gate facing the community center next.

There was a request to get more funds to get new fencing for the improved gates so that the fencing on the gates matches the fencing around the rest of the garden. The fencing need would be approximately \$81 for $4' \times 100'$ fencing; the surplus fencing will be saved to be used for future projects.

 Ceil moved to approve the additional funding of \$81, Beck LaSur Martin 2nd motion Motion approved to provide \$81 to Children's Garden for fencing improvements

Dorie reports that there are about 8 more beds to have compost added and will then be closed for the Winter.

Ed said he has the permissions and could also give permission to others to add and edit

After a little more discussion, it was decided that Ed would start to post a calendar on the website for use to look at as a trial run then vote upon acceptance/changes at the next meeting in November.

 White Oak Acrons – Laura brought sprouted white oak acrons for members to take if they want; she also has more at home

Rebecca Snell mentioned that they will germinate now so it is best to keep the tap root moist and plant to encourage growth. It can even be planted in a Dixie Cup for now and then transplanted to the ground later. This was a great segue into tonight's program presentation about Oak Masting.
